To The Development Plans Manager,

Dear Sir,

I have read with dismay the updated schedule relating to 35 dwellings at Kingsley Avenue, Swarthmoor. Nr.Ulverston.

Having registered my anxiety at the dangerous situation at the road junction of Kingsley Avenue and Rufus Lane (outside my house) I now know for sure that no-one at SLDC is at all interested in the opinions or concerns of local residents.

The said junction i.e. the "existing access" in your document, is some two hundred metres from the A590 and is just-and-so wide enough for two cars to pass WHEN THERE ARE NO VEHICLES PARKED THERE which is hardly ever.

As vehicles park on both sides of the road almost all of the time the result is single file traffic, often backing up on to the main A590. One accident has already happened as a result.

Thirty-five more dwellings will mean thirty-five more cars (at least) and thirty-five more chances of a serious accident happening at this junction.

Does anyone at SLDC care?

Obviously not!
