

I oppose the proposition to re-classify the two fields accessed via Union Lane for the following reasons.

Green field land is a great asset to towns and once lost can never be replaced.

Access is not suitable for more traffic, during the building period hundreds of visitors to the Health Centre are forced down narrow roads, Star Street and Sun Street.

The suggestion that Mowings Lane be used is not a viable alternative. The top of this road is very narrow with no prospect of widening it. It is not a realistic entry road due to its steepness. Equally the exit via this route is unsuitable as it gives a blind entry on to Old Hall road or Southgate, or down Garden Terrace to a very busy junction taking traffic to & from the Health Centre, to and from Sun Street + The Gill car park all meeting at an old people's home.
