on to the top of Mowings Lane. and down the hill. This could be a very big problem when winter arrives with ice and snow on the hill. The gutter can not get up ~~the~~ to the top, so we have to clear it out self. This could be accidents that will cause chaos, with the amount of traffic, going up or down.

4. We have lived here 45 years coming from Manchester area with our 3 children, now grown up. The area is peaceful with green fields all around. Gill banks was a fun place for the children when they were young
