

Dear Sir/Madam,

I would like to register my objections to the proposed, Development of Union Lane Fields, in Ulverston.

- 1) These two fields are elevated from the town and according to the South Lakeland Local Development Framework Land Allocations Development Plan 2012, are poor in relation to air quality and Flood risk !!!!!!
- 2) SLDC state in their plan that Natural/semi-natural greenspace and green corridors only cover small parts of the town.
- 3) Access to the site, increased volume of traffic in the area, the surrounding roads are not capable of coping with the increase. At the top end of the site, Mowings lane is currently an unmetallised track, and is used by the public to access Gill Banks.
- 4) Wildlife habitat, these fields support Tawny Owls, and a fairly large colony of Bats. Development of the site will affect light and noise levels in Gill Banks, and hence will greatly reduce the habitat for them to able to feed, and survive. Has a risk assessment been conducted into the effects on the wild life, if such a development goes ahead.
