The sewerage system in Urswick Road appears to be already overloaded due to the addition of waste disposal from the High Carley housing site. It is well known that when the sewerage pumping system at High Carley is in operation, that sewer gas escapes into the Urswick Rd. area. I understand that new road gullies and sealed inspection covers have been fitted but the problem still persists. The Urswick Road site would drain through the same sewer. As residents we do not want this problem to become worse.
