I am a resident living at . Having read the proposed plans I wish to register my concerns and objections on the following basis:

- 1. The scale of development will be out of keeping with this part of Kendal bordering a conservation area.
- 2. The entrance to Kendal from Underbarrow road is one of the most attractive features of the town with its elegant houses and impression of open space and countryside just at the border of Kendal.
- 3. Historic features in this area include the lime kiln, golf course and wooded areas. Views from the golf course and Kendal fell (popular areas for local walks) will be adversely affected by over development in terms of housing and recycling facilities. All these historic and natural features are important for residents of Kendal and visiting tourists.
- 4. The industrial steel clad buildings passed for development in recent years at the entry to the waste depo. are already spoiling the appearance of this part of town and further decline will result if this plan is passed. Why site waste recycling facilities so close to domestic properties?! They clearly have attendant problems of pollution (including below the surface strata). Rubbish blows off open carts into our gardens (as frequently happens) and existing problems with smells and noise can only be exacerbated by the plans that are being put forward.
- 5. Increased traffic, noise, and safety concerns for families living close by would be a real issue. This will add to existing problems with speeding and vehicles ignoring the 7.5 ton limit.
- 6. This is currently a great area for local wildlife. I have recently seen badgers, peregrine falcons and a wide variety of local wildlife whose habitat may well be affected.
- 6. More surface water run off is also likely to cause flooding problems if an estate of this size is built at this site.
