- 1. Local people are under the impression that the proposed allocation of the land at Burneside Football/Tennis court site, the land was given to the people of Burneside by Henry Willinck for them to enjoy and use, which they do. The site is used on a regular basis for Football and Tennis.
- 2. The current sewage and drainage system is up to capacity and cannot cope with more, regular excess water ie rain, from the football pitch resulting in water flowing down both sides of the road, pooling outside the Bryce Institute. Poor sewage drainage resulting in blocking of the sewers and smells in and around private dwellings around the afore mentioned site. Around the church, in heavy rain, sewage escapes through the manholes resulting in problems when using the poor bus service. A new sewage system was proposed 25 years ago when the Cowan Head project went ahead but nil happened. Flooding has been a major problem and the addition of all these new houses will make it much worse.
- 3. Traffic in the village is a major concern. Many drivers speed on all the roads through the village, many villagers will not use the back road due to it being narrow with poor visability, private cars are the main concern, many drivers using Burneside as a short cut to the Morrisons side of Kendal. All the sites are on these roads will have access concerns. Issues concerning traffic have been raised many times but nil has happened all of the roads are prone, again to flooding in bad weather.
- 4. New homes possibly being too expensive for locals to buy, so either being purchased as holiday homes or let as DHSS housing. Local employment is poor and where are people going to work, will this bring an increased drug and antisocial to concerns to the village. School not adequate for more children, currently problems with working parents due to no breakfast club and limited after school activities. Poor bus service to use entertainment facilities in Kendal, as last Bus to Burneside at 17.45 hours and no Sunday service, not all trains stop at Burneside and both modes of transport expensive as are local Taxies.
- 5. Burneside is a good little village, and has continued to maintain its village atmosphere, this will cease with addition of more housing. Some of the current New Builds in Kendal appear to remain unsold, with the above concerns why would new housing in Burneside be any different, the addition of new homes will only bring negatives to the village.
