



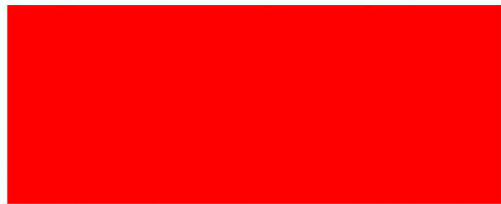

B108 might be an area for development as it would have less interference with existing properties.

R43 The site is green field and within the current boundary of the Village Conservation Area. It is of considerable area. If designated for development it would significantly alter the shape of the main housing ~~development~~ disposition of the Village. Development would compromise the viewed outline of the church as seen between the Wheatshof and Old P.O. Access to the area is via Mill Lane which is private and unadopted. The residents of Parsonage Fold are under financial burden for its upkeep. The adjacent complex of Parsonage Fold was not an extension to the building boundaries when the former Parsonage Farm outbuildings were converted for dwelling.
