Re. Site Reference R121 M,

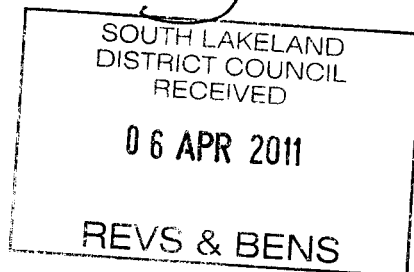
