ARNSIDE : A9 HOLLINS LANE. :-

I object to the proposal to build eight houses on A9. This would be a difficult and problematic site as the lane is one of the most (if not the most) narrow lanes in Arnside at this point. Two vehicles cannot pass & any parked vehicle would mean that emergency service vehicles, refuse collection, deliveries etc. would not be able to get up or down. The lane already has more traffic than it can cope with as it is on a 'Sat - Nav' route. Even at quiet times or the day the traffic is constant and at busy times - gridlock. The speed of the traffic is also a cause for concern - much too fast - drivers not taking into consideration the lack of pavements & blind bends. The access to the site is unsuitable & would necessitate blocking the road at times, causing problems for residents. The proposed site also has a drain running straight through it from the houses above which is prone to blockage & would be required to be encased in concrete.

I believe that there is a much more suitable site at A15 (used at the moment as low-grade grazing land):-

- 1) Light local traffic only
- 2) Access road at Lawrence Drive already in place.
- 3) Very easy access from Red Hills Road.
- 4) Drains etc. already in place.

Therefore a much more workable site.
