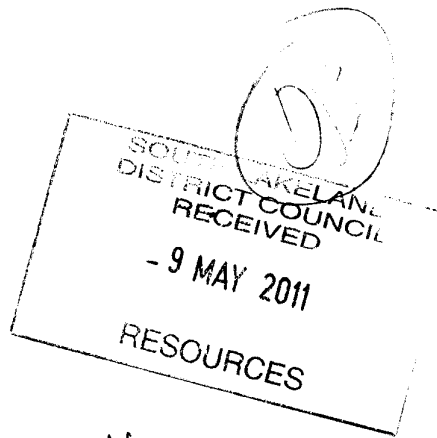

Dear Mr. McNeil,

We read in Grange Now, May edition, that it is still not too late to write regarding development issues.

We have previously corresponded with you over development in field R685, 40 properties proposed in Flookburgh.

May we have this letter placed on file with our previous ones on this matter?

Recently we have had to call out United Utilities to a matter of raw sewage invading our piece of garden-ground rented from S.L.D.C., this is adjacent to field R.685. We grow fruit and vegetables on this piece of land.

We now know that there are two breaches in this main sewer pipe, one about 10 inches and covered only with a slab of stone. The second somewhere in Bridge House retirement home which comes up in their lawn!

Tree roots have also been found growing into this main sewer. As best as is possible the pipe has been jetted, but the workers say it is at best 30% efficient. Further work is obviously needed, but as yet it has not been started.

We think this should be brought to the attention of any developer in future plans for R685, as the main sewer is clearly not suitable to take the waste from 40 more houses.

If any development takes place on R.685 a completely new main sewer should be made available as a priority.
