I would like to comment on the alternative site RN331#.

I believe this is by far the best site for the housing developments in Kirkby for the following reasons.

* Any development which relies on access from Kendal Road is totally unacceptable as it is already overloaded with traffic.

* Access from the Booths roundabout is excellent for vehicles.

* Any development south of the booths roundabout is within easy walking distance from the Surgery, Post Office , Booths, and the centre of town. The proposed development to the west of the town is far enough to tempt residents to drive into town.

* There was the argument that development to the south would set a president. But that already exists with Biggins and Robraine.

* Another objection was that it would spoil the image of KL with housing on both sides of the road. This could be addressed by leaving a narrow strip of trees and scrubs between the new development and the road.
