Query/comment My concerns re development of housing for RN205, RN331, RN292 & RN238 -

I couldn't see the reference for RN293 - you cannot ring fence Kirkby Lonsdale with housing nor

can you ring fence the school with further development. The infra structure to service an extensive housing

development is just not there. The school is at bursting point, the library is under threat, the shopping facilities

are dominated by one super market, the chemist is a poor one and the dental service could not cope nor could the medical

facilities. Public transport links to the railway station, kendal or other parts of cumbria are also very poor.

The proposed sites would impose serious strains on the services already provided albeit they are not first class.

We need to preserve the little remaining countryside that we have for future generations and maintain the

pleasure of people coming out to the countryside for a breath of fresh air and relaxation.

This area should be part of a national park and not subject to the pressures of overworked development which quickly, from examining the south of england. takes on the appearance of a very tired and strained look.

Farming should be encouraged and energies turned to maintain what little land is available for producing our

own foods and at the same time preserving open spaces which are a relief from the congestion of towns and cities

which gives people the mental and physical relaxation that is important to their well being. To this end we should

continue to develop tourism rather than congested development.
