I would like to register my objection to the proposed housing development in the fields behind Raygarth and Fairbank, Kirkby Lonsdale.

My main reasons for objecting are;

1. That we have already have two low cost/ affordable housing developments in this area, one being Raygarth Gardens.
2. The entrance into KL down Fairbank and through the town is very narrow and dangerous for pedestrians from Fairgarth Drive and the three Retirement Homes on Fairbank.
3. The two schools in Kirkby Lonsdale are already full to capacity and the indiscriminate and unpoliced illegal parking during the periods 8.30/9.00am and 3.00pm / 3.45pm are a fatal accident waiting to happen. (Hopefully any site visit to the area by Councillors will not take place during school holidays as happened with the site visit when Masters Grange on Biggins Road was approved, much against the wishes of all concerned with road safety)
