Reference: **Local Development Framework Land Allocations – Further Consultation.**

Dear Sir,

- (i) Land allocation document should cover 10 years
- (ii)
 - a) Sites for development should be on land **adjoining** existing urban areas where public services and amenities already in place can be provided at an acceptable cost.
 - b) Where development has been identified such as in Little Urswick the only amenities are a bus service which is now much reduced because it was the most expensive to subsidise in Cumbria, there are no shops and no facilities for younger people.
 - c) Increased traffic, with narrow lanes with no footpaths and increased parking.
