I note the above sites have been put forward by respondents to the consultation. There are strong arguments for any developments in Leasingill consolidating the existing linear development of the settlement.

RN 325 and 324 (cc 109) would effectively represent an extension rather than an infilling consolidation. The way in which the settlement "tapers out" to the north is one of its features and

should be maintained as part of preserving its rare rural character.

Development in these fields would be detrimental to the character of the settlement and its situation in its landscape
