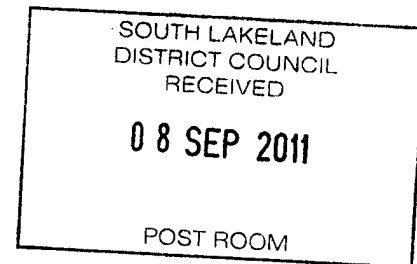

Local Development Framework.

1. Housing: Following the Public Meeting, in Holme, on March 10th 2011, Holme Parish Council agreed in principle to R674HM; R655M & R675M but felt that R653M would be the most appropriate area for development in view of the number of houses required and including the adjoining green area for recreation.

2. Employment: The Council considers M35M – with the main entrance on Milnthorpe Road – to be acceptable.

3. Further Consultation - 2011: The areas suggested on this document are considered to be far in excess of any requirements. Additionally, several of the proposed areas are adjacent to the M6 motorway and the main North/South railway line or are in other scattered areas where it would be extremely difficult to provide adequate services at a reasonable cost.

Details of the 'Further Consultation' have been widely displayed in the village including in the Post Office, the Parish Hall, on the Parish Council Notice Boards and at Holme Club so that all residents have had the opportunity to put forward their views.

Virtually all comments received by the Parish Council, both verbal and in writing, stress the overall feeling amongst residents that Holme is not suitable for any further large development, especially when taking into account all the building which has taken place over the last ten years.

The Council understands that you have received letters direct from residents of the village and enclose copies of those which we have received.

In view of the above, the Council's original comments regarding future building in the village remain unchanged.

The Parish Council has worked in cooperation with the SLDC over the last four years and wishes to continue this dialogue and now looks forward to meeting with you again in the near future./
