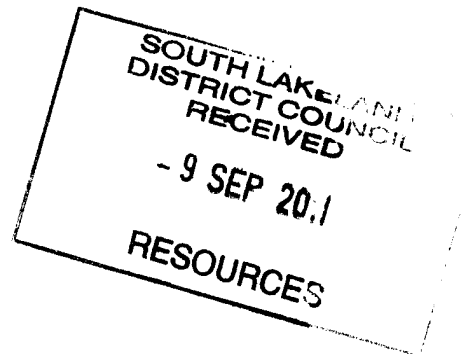

I am writing to say how dismayed I am to see that there is a possible development being considered on the above land.

The access to the land is very limited and would result in a **large** increase in traffic and noise, as every household would have at **least** two cars.

It is also well know that the sewage system is not robust enough to cope with the increased number of homes.

The amenities in Burton are limited to a butcher and Post Office, and a pub.

I cannot see any benefit in covering the gently rolling hills with more dwellings and ruining the view of Farleton Knott.

Brownfield sites should be used before anything else.

I hope you will look on this kindly, as the area in which we live is important to us.
