<p>This area of Ulverston has already experienced devastating flooding and should this proposal go ahead yet another built up area would inevitably cause even more strain on an already overloaded drain and sewer system plus the loss of open land which presently can absorb extensive rain fall thereby slowing the flood process. It would also cause even more traffic flow (and noise) and make it even more difficult to exit North Lonsdale Road onto the A590 than it does at the moment. At busy times it can take up to 5 minutes to turn left at this junction. The large housing estate that was built in the last 5 years by Lund Farm was supposed to result in a better traffic flow system at the junction of the A590 and this never materialised thereby exacerbating existing problems.</p> <p>This area of Ulverston already has many industrial units(some of which still stand empty) which have sprung up in the 20 years I have lived here and enough is enough. I didn't buy this property to live in the middle of an industrial site.</p>
