Timally, access to site RN 279 is exhemited. limited - currently only via a small strip the cul-de-sac end of Barning. This involves a Tight blind turn and dogled to enter, and with three houses facing outs it, as well as being a busy turning area for the road. There are also deep concerns about the extra load on ulilities, and about drains and sourage as Barning is not connected to the main drains. If the proposal K.
