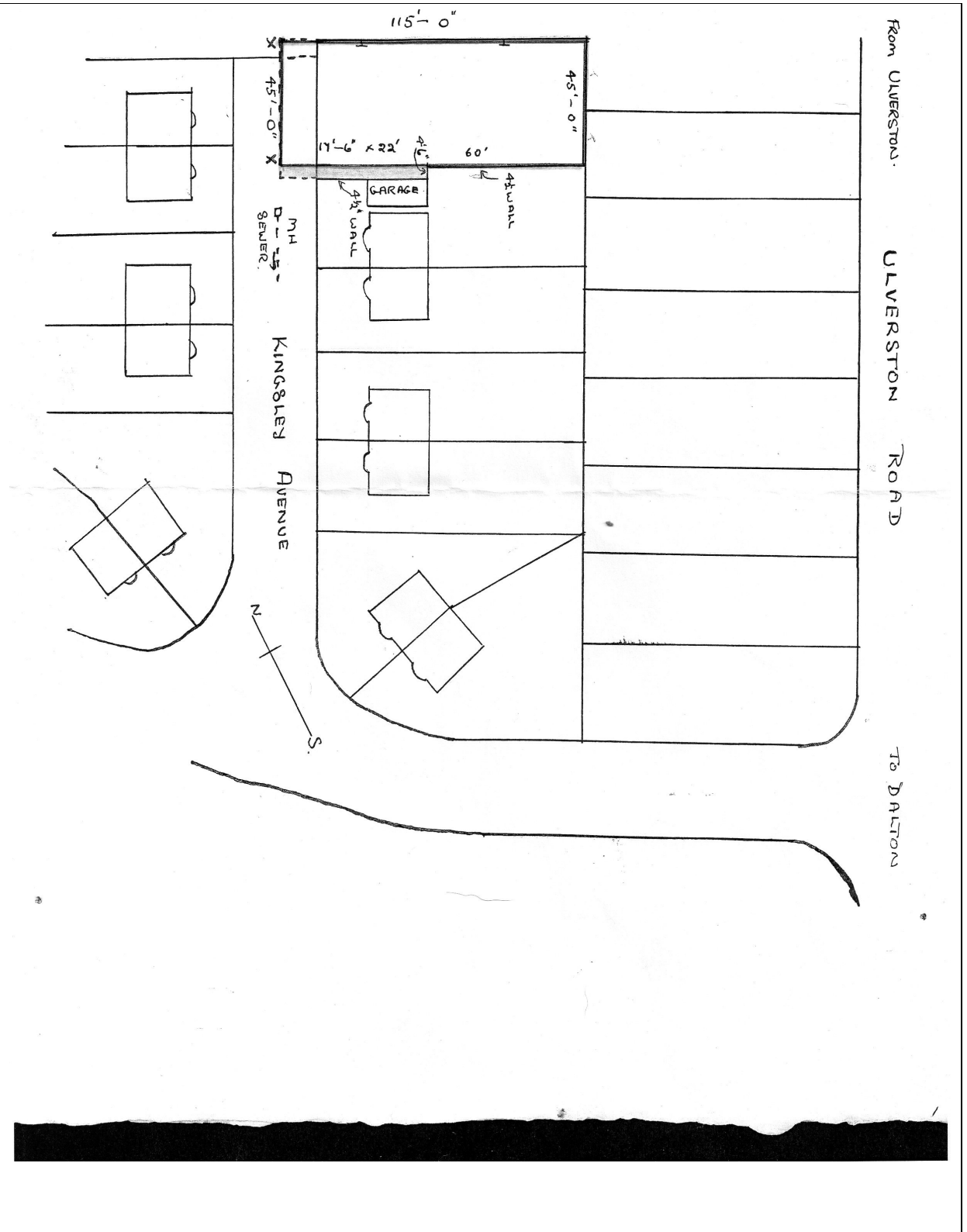

<p>I wish to offer my objections to the proposal of extending the housing off Kingsley Avenue. Besides taking a swathe of approximately 200ft of prime agricultural land which will leave a small field unlikely to be adequate for farming purposes. A similar situation applies to location RN109M and R687SW on map 41. The accumulation of small size greenfield sites that the government is submitting for consideration will have a huge impact on the agricultural land of the country, particularly considering the forecasted increase in the future population of the country.</p> <p>Regarding site R684SW, over the number of years living in Kingsley Ave, numerous people have visited the Ave t view the scenery from the end of the Avenue. A comment that is regular heard is that the view is unique in the Furness area, overlooking Ulverston Hoad and the surrounding hills, the field providing an ideal foreground. I have spoken to many locals and all agree it would be a sacrilege to build on this site.</p> <p>Besides the impact of increasing the traffic problems when trying to get onto the A590 through Swarthmoor, the proposal of building on sites RN109M, R687SW and R684SW on the West side of the A590 will also split the villiage into two halves. Any children wanting to go to the public playground will have to cross the already very dangerous A590.</p> <p>We would also like to point out that 14 Kinsley Avenue owns a small piece of land protruding onto the road proposed for the main through road to the proposed development. See attached conveyance document.</p>
