- c)SLDC also refused to consider seriously the Town Council's alternative stategy based on the Taylor Review (he said you do not just build and build on the edges of our existing market town(s))
- d)SLDC's landscape assessment document (Gillespies) had errors gardens in Sedbergh Road listed for development for example
- e) The Stock Beck Flood Alleviation Scheme and climate change seem to be disregarded
- f)Biodiversity and the Great Created Newt Colony were passed over
- g) There was an obvious lack of site preparation. Are the issues of highways, flooding, landscape and biodiversity going to be left until much later before being looked at in detail?
- h)No serious infrastructure plans or proposes have appeared or are available to show how the vision statement for 2025 will be achieved in reality
