Further development on Hollins Lane is not desirable for the following reasons :-

- 1) A narrow lane with no footpaths.
- 2) Poorly lit by road lighting.
- 3) No surface road drainage - storm water flows downhill to Briary Bank.
- 4) Unnecessary additional road traffic caused by vehicles using short cut from Silverdale Road to Briary Bank - instead of exiting Silverdale Road by Fire Station and also in reverse direction.

This creates additional problems for children walking to school - see also Para 1.
