## Your comments

The proposed settlement hierarchy for the AONB is supported in principle.

The choice of which spatial option is best to accommodate new housing and other development within the AONB to meet local requirements within the plan period, must be founded on the settlement hierarchy but must ensure that local needs are capable of being met where they arise, such that some limited growth should be permitted in all but the smallest villages and hamlets. It is likely that the chosen option will be a hybrid that emerges from those set out at present. A combination of Option (ii) and Option (v) is the most reasonable and sustainable spatial distribution at present but this is, as yet, without reference to a proposed and tested housing requirement for the AONB. This would allow planned (allocation) and windfall allowance sources of supply to come forward.
