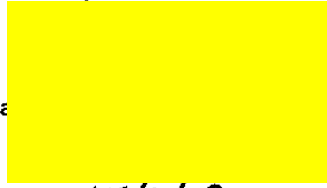

Dear Mr. Hudson,

Thank you for your correspondence of the 31st May & 6th June 2012.

I note the contents of the letter & the 'Summary of Response'.

I cannot open the information you have taken from my correspondence & transposed into a computerised format, however I feel that I should reiterate one or two points:-

FIRSTLY - Arncliffe is in an AONB & relies on the beauty of its area to attract visitors. As such, it surely is given protection by recent Government decisions.

SECONDLY - Arncliffe does not need an increase of general housing. There are currently, at 70 houses on the market. However, there is, I agree, a small need for some suitably placed 'Low cost' homes. Perhaps, there is a need for some rented properties. I know, from experience, how hard it is to get on the home ownership ladder!

THIRDLY - Facilities in Arncliffe are not great. No bank or petrol station. No train to Kendal. Poor bus services. Narrow roads etc. An increase in population will not help.
