ALTERATIONS TO THE EXISTING BUILDING BOUNDARY, KIRKBY-IN-FURNESS

We object to any extension of the boundary within which buildings may be constructed in the Parish of Kirkby Ireleth for the following reasons:

- 1) The infrastructure of sewage, gas, electricity and water would be inadequate if there is an added strain upon supplies.
- 2) Transportation problems and access onto the A595 would increase onto an already crowded and dangerous road system.
- 3) There are many houses for sale within the parish and it is patently obvious that there is no need for further development.
- 4) The areas chosen by SLDC have many structural and ease of access problems.
- 5) Any enlargement of the Four lane Ends area would have an effect upon the visual aspect of the community.
- 6) The character of the area would change dramatically if the housing stock were increased by the proposed 25%.
