





Field R449 has a lot of wild life deer, pheasants, squirrels, seabirds etc. The lane at the bottom of field R449 is very narrow, more traffic would make it very dangerous. Grange does not need big housing estates, they would look totally out of place. These fields especially R449 is a continuous area of green fields. I strongly do not support building in these fields, they should be left as green.</p>
