The area marked as 'M41KM' adjacent to Kumbury Rd appears to be totally unsuitable for high density housing.

Milnthorpe Rd is already a very busy road, especially used by emergency vehicles and with a proposed estate of 141 houses there will introduce a further 2-300 cars onto this road. Pedestrian access and vehicle entry/exit onto this road is already difficult at most times of the day. The main industry for Cumbria is

tourism and Kendal is often referred to as 'The Gateway to the Lakes'. Why therefore proceed with this proposal and the employment area termed as 'E4M' also in Milnthorpe Rd when these will have a negative effect on the approach

to Kendal, which at the moment is highly attractive.

A 'Preservation Order' was placed on the line of lime trees adjacent to this estate in order to maintain this attractive approach. Also any alterations on the 'Southern approach' are also strictly maintained.

Considering the number of empty business premises in and around Kendal, I would have thought that a different suggestion would have been made.

I would like to be kept informed of alterations to the scheme or when it is submitted to the Secretary of State
