There are several issues raised in the scheme which are commendable but I fail to understand why the Green belt field on the North side of Cartmel Road Grange should be included. This is not a site which would attract affordable housing, it would be developed with further up market property which is not currently a necessity in the town.

The very nature of the occupancy of Grange is such that there is a constant flow of property into a market place which is already saturated with many properties which have been on the market for months.

To release this field would take away the brake between residential property and holiday caravan accommodation, we must not loose Green belt, particularly a location which provides a haven for wildlife, passerine birds, fox, deer and even the protected badger have been visitors to the field.

As a former resident of Ambleside, where together with Coniston, Windermere and Grasmere, the need for affordable housing is unquestionable, I do not understand why these areas are excluded from the Authority proposals.
