I support the building of new dwellings at sites R489M (Hall Park Extension) and M38M (Willink Recreation Field)

If building on M38M was authorised there would have to be at least the same amount of recreational facilities replicated elsewhere in the village and I would suggest this could be done next or near to the football field at Hollins Lane SF31. This would remove the recreational field away from residential areas and keep them together.

There has been a problem with sewerage disposal for a long time in the village. I therefore suggest the following -

A sewerage plant to be developed in the village to cope with the existing sewerage and any future development.

This would be cheaper than upgrading the pipework to Wattfield, Kendal which is already over subscribed.

Staveley, which is probably smaller than Burneside has its' own plant. In the past Burneside had a sewerage treatment area in the field next to the bus stop at Junction Cottages. Part of the walls can still be seen.
