

Dear Sir,
Because besides being not computer literate, I have severe mobility difficulties and am DISABLED requiring a Disability badge - I MUST, while I agree with all my husband has already sent by Email about the SITES under consideration I MUST add more comments as a disabled person.

The disabled NEED Access to both the doctor's Surgery (in Orchard Road) and the Dentist's Surgery in Silverdale Road.
I was told by the representative from Lancaster City Council on our visit to the Education Institute that it would be possible to put disabled parking bays

- ① Near the doctor's surgery in Orchard Road and
- ② Near the dentist's surgery in the Silverdale Road

The disabled parking bay would have to be on the opposite side to the doctor's surgery to avoid blocking Orchard Road.

on the Silverdale Road (a busy road) such a bay would probably have to be on the same side as the surgery as there are always so many vehicles parked on the opposite side to the surgery that it is very difficult for any driver with a disabled passenger to park.

There are essential for the REGULAR NEEDS of Such Patients

AT THE STATION it is important that the Disabled Parking for the Southbound Trains REMAINE

But disabled parking is needed on STATION ROAD for Northbound Trains

It is impossible for disabled people to cross that railway bridge unaided

When it is windy it is impossible even with a
strong companion to assist
